
ORDER

Comes on for consideration on the application of Receiver, Stephen J. Moriarty (“Receiver”), for entry of an order establishing a procedure to notify creditors and requiring that, if necessary, they file a proof of claim setting forth the nature and amount of their claims (Docket # 183)(the “Application”). After reviewing the Application and being fully advised in the premises, the Court FINDS that good cause exists to grant the Application.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Notice will be given by the Receiver as required by law.
2. A bar date for the filing of claims is set for December 31, 2011. Creditors will be given notice that, if filing a claim is required, failure to timely file will result in no distribution in this case.
3. To the extent that an Investor agrees with the amounts set forth in the Receiver's Report Regarding Investor Claims filed on October 24, 2011 (Docket #181), they do not need to file a claim with the Court. To the extent they disagree, they must file a claim with the Court detailing the nature and extent of their claim. Notice to Investors of the foregoing shall be made in the form set forth in Exhibit "A" to the Application.
4. Notice to Creditors, in the form set forth in Exhibit "B" to the Application, shall be published at least once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper with general circulation in Oklahoma County, Oklahoma and Charleston County, South Carolina.
5. Receiver shall mail the Notice to Creditors to all known creditors by regular mail.
6. To the extent a creditor must file a claim, it shall be filed with this court and a copy sent to Receiver, in the form set forth in Exhibit "C" to the Application.
