Appellee's brief is due July 6, 2003.**
- 98,139 Wayne Trobee v. Phillip R. Clifton a/k/a Clayton and Victor Deck, individually; and Phillip R. Clifton a/k/a Clayton and Victor Deck d/b/a Elite Auctions, L.L.C. **Appellee is granted to July 16, 2003 to file brief.**
