DEFAULT JUDGMENT

On the 17th day of September, 2008, the captioned matter came before this Court on the *Application for Order Enforcing Administrative Order* ("Application") of Plaintiff, Oklahoma Department of Securities ("Department") *ex rel.* Irving L. Faught, Administrator, against Defendant, Christopher R. Moreno ("Defendant Moreno"). The Court, having reviewed the *Agreement* executed by the parties on February 25, 2008 ("Agreement"), *Order to Cease and Desist* issued by Plaintiff against Defendant Moreno on February 25, 2008 ("Administrative Order"), Application, summons, and return of service, finds that Defendant Moreno has been validly served with the Application and summons, that the date by which Defendant Moreno was required to answer or further plead to the Application was July 10, 2008, and that no answer or further pleading has been filed on his behalf.

The Court, having heard the evidence presented, and being fully advised, finds that Defendant is in default and has thus admitted the substantive allegations of the Application, that the allegations of Plaintiff's Application are deemed true as therein set forth and that Plaintiff is entitled to a judgment finding Defendant Moreno in civil contempt of the Administrative Order and ordering Defendant Moreno to: (1) send, via certified mail, return receipt requested, a

cashier's check or money order in the amount of \$ 2,400, the sum of all payments past due under the terms of the Agreement, to the Investor identified by Plaintiff in connection with the Agreement, within twenty-four (24) hours of receiving notice of the entry of such order; and (2) comply with the Administrative Order and the Agreement in the future.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Defendant Moreno is in civil contempt of the Administrative Order and that Defendant Moreno shall: (1) send, via certified mail, return receipt requested, a cashier's check or money order in the amount of \$ 2,400, the sum of all payments past due under the terms of the Agreement, to the Investor identified by Plaintiff in connection with the Agreement, within twenty-four hours of receiving notice of the entry of this Order; and (2) comply with the Administrative Order and the Agreement in the future.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


