**APPLICATION FOR ORDER REGARDING DISBURSEMENT OF NECESSARY
EXPENSES FOR INTERVENOR
WITH COURT APPROVAL**

COMES NOW Christiana K. Roark ("Intervenor") and respectfully makes application to the Court for the entry of an Order extending the previous Order of the Court for her necessary monthly living expenses in the amount of \$500.00 per month. In support of this Application, Intervenor shows the Court as follows:

1. Bryan Roark died on October 24, 2009. Intervenor is the widow of Bryan Roark.
2. Intervenor is a schoolteacher with no outside source of income other than her compensation as a schoolteacher.
3. On November 4, 2009 Plaintiff, Oklahoma Department of Securities, brought this action against the Estate of Bryan Roark.
4. On January 13, 2010, Intervenor filed an application for payment of her interim attorney fees and for payment of reasonable expenses.
5. The Court entered its "Order Granting, In Part, Interim Application ... for Attorney's Fees and Costs and Extending, In Part, the Order of December 10, 2009."

In that Order the Court ordered:

“that for the period beginning December 1, 2009 through January 31, 2010, a monthly disbursement of \$500.00 will be paid to Intervenor C. Roark by the Receiver from the Receivership Assets.”

6. That temporary order was premised on the assumption that the Plaintiff, Oklahoma Department of Securities, would have completed its analysis of the claims and this matter would be resolved. Due to the complexity of this matter, the Plaintiff has been unable to complete its analysis.

7. The Court entered an Order on February 17, 2010, providing for a payment of \$500.00 to Intervenor for the month of February, 2010.

5. Until this action is fully resolved, Intervenor will be unable to fully manage her financial affairs, and is in need of continued financial assistance.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, Intervenor respectfully requests that the Court enter an Order directing the Receiver to pay to Intervenor the sum of \$500.00 per month for the months of March and April, 2010.
