ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH ROARK FAMILY

On June 21, 2010, the *Joint Application for Approval of Settlement Agreement With Roark Family* that the Oklahoma Department of Securities and Receiver filed on June 2, 2010 comes before the Court for consideration. The Plaintiff, Oklahoma Department of Securities, appears by and through its counsel of record, Jennifer Shaw and Amanda Cornmesser. The Receiver appears by and through his counsel of record, Bradley Davenport. The Intervenors, Christiana K. Roark, Chad Roark and Craig Roark, appear by and through their counsel of record, Clell I. Cunningham, III.

Based on the pleadings and submissions of the parties, the Court finds as follows:

1. That a Notice of Hearing was mailed to all counsel of record for parties in this case and to the creditors, who filed a Proof of Claim form with the Receivership estate, and/or their legal counsel;
2. That no response or objection to the *Joint Application for Approval of Settlement Agreement with Roark Family* has been filed of record as of the hearing date;
3. That no party, creditor or attorney for any party or creditor involved in this matter appearing in person at the hearing has raised any verbal objection or made any argument in

opposition to the proposed settlement agreement among the Oklahoma Department of Securities, the Receiver and the Roark family; and,

4. That the proposed settlement agreement appears fair and equitable under the circumstances and would allow the Receiver to recover significant additional assets on behalf of the creditors and claimants of the Receivership estate without incurring the time and expense involved in litigating the issues addressed by the settlement agreement, and therefore, the settlement agreement should be approved by the Court.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the *Joint Application for Approval of Settlement Agreement With Roark Family* filed on June 2, 2010 by the Oklahoma Department of Securities and Receiver is **GRANTED**, and the Settlement Agreement attached as Exhibit "D" to the *Joint Application for Approval of Settlement Agreement with Roark Family* is approved by this Court.


