It appears to this Court from the facts alleged in Plaintiff's Petition that Plaintiff is entitled to the immediate relief requested. It further appears that the public will suffer irreparable damage and injury unless this Order is entered.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant Grose, his agents, servants, employees, assigns, and those persons acting on his behalf, under his direction and control and/or in active concert or participation with him who receive actual notice of this Order by personal service, facsimile or otherwise, be and hereby are, until further notice of this Court, enjoined from tampering with, mutilating, altering, erasing, concealing, removing, destroying or otherwise disposing of any and all books, records, documents,

files, correspondence, computer disks, tapes or other data recordings of any type, pertaining to or referring to Defendant Grose; Quest Resource Corporation; Quest Energy Partners L.P.; Rockport Energy, LLC; Rodger H. Brooks; RHB Global LLC; Affiliated Energy Partners, L.L.C.; Oklahoma Hydrogen Technology, LLC; and any of their subsidiaries or affiliates.


