DEFAULT JUDGMENT
AGAINST DEFENDANT CHRISTOPHER S. VONWERDER

This matter came on for hearing before this Court on this 23rd day of November, 2009, on the motion of Plaintiff for default judgment against Defendant Christopher S. VonWerder.

The Court, having reviewed all pleadings and evidence, finds that Defendant Christopher S. VonWerder is in default for failure to answer or otherwise plead to the *Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief* (Petition) filed on July 24, 2009, and their time for doing so has expired. The Court, being fully advised in the premises, and on consideration thereof, finds that the allegations in the Petition are

deemed true as therein set forth with respect to Defendant Christopher S. VonWerder and that Plaintiff is entitled to the relief prayed for and, therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a permanent injunction be and is hereby entered, forever enjoining and restraining Defendant Christopher S. VonWerder from offering and/or selling securities in and/or from this state.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant Christopher S. VonWerder pay restitution to all investors who purchased Debentures from the Defendants or who transferred money to the Defendants for the purpose of purchasing the Debentures or otherwise making investments on their behalf; and that the amount and allocation of restitution to investors shall be determined by this Court at the conclusion of this case.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant Christopher S. VonWerder be ordered to disgorge all ill-gotten gains achieved through the sale or potential sale of the Debentures or other investment vehicle, and that the amount shall be determined by the Court at the conclusion of this case.

IT IS SO ORDERED.




