DEFAULT JUDGMENT
AGAINST DEFENDANT TOMMY L. RICHARDSON
AND RELIEF DEFENDANT AMY J. RICHARDSON

This matter came on for hearing before this Court on this 8th day of October, 2009, on the motion of Plaintiff for default judgment against Defendant Tommy L. Richardson and Relief Defendant Amy J. Richardson.

The Court, having reviewed all pleadings and evidence, finds that Defendant Tommy L. Richardson and Relief Defendant Amy J. Richardson are in default for failure to answer or otherwise plead to the July 24, 2009, *Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief* (Petition), and their time for doing so has expired. The Court,

being fully advised in the premises, and on consideration thereof, finds that the allegations in Plaintiff's Petition are deemed true as therein set forth with respect to Defendant Tommy L. Richardson and Relief Defendant Amy J. Richardson and that Plaintiff is entitled to the relief prayed for and, therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a permanent injunction be and is hereby entered, forever enjoining and restraining Defendant Tommy L. Richardson from offering and/or selling securities in and/or from this state.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant Tommy L. Richardson pay restitution to all investors who purchased Debentures from the Defendants or who transferred money to the Defendants for the purpose of purchasing the Debentures or otherwise making investments on their behalf; and that the amount and allocation of restitution to investors shall be determined by this Court at the conclusion of this case.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant Tommy L. Richardson and Relief Defendant Amy J. Richardson be ordered to disgorge all ill-gotten gains achieved through the sale or potential sale of the Debentures or other investment vehicle, and that the amount shall be determined at the Court at the conclusion of this case.

IT IS SO ORDERED.




