**McAFEE & TAFT, P.C.'s APPLICATION  
FOR PAYMENT OF ATTORNEY FEES AND COSTS**

COMES NOW, the law firm of McAfee & Taft, P.C. ("McAfee"), counsel of record for Defendants Jimmy W. Gray, Michael K. Gray and Lance P. Bowman ("Movants") and moves the Court for an order awarding McAfee its reasonable attorney's fees incurred in assisting the Receiver in preserving, identifying and collection of the claims and assets of the corporate Defendants subject to the receivership herein.

McAfee seeks an award of \$50,221.37 in attorney's fees and costs to be paid out of the assets of the Receivership.

## APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF COMPENSATION

1. By this Application, McAfee seeks entry of an order allowing payment for reimbursement for attorneys whose services have been rendered in this matter as well as costs.

2. All services for which compensation is requested in this Application by McAfee are legal services and none of the services for which compensation is requested were performed by any person other than McAfee.


3. McAfee's Receivership Fees in the amount of \$38,388.37 have been reviewed and approved by the Receiver in Receiver's First Annual Accounting filed on November 24, 2014.

4. McAfee has incurred additional attorney fees and costs in the amount of \$11,833.00 in continuation of their efforts to assist Receiver in preserving, locating and collecting Receivership assets, as well as prosecuting claims against the brokers who received undisclosed commission, in cash or by check, from the funds contributed by investors to the corporate defendants. The Receiver has been provided statements for the additional attorney fees and has approved the same.

5. At the direction of McAfee's clients, McAfee has fully cooperated and diligently assisted the Receiver with respect to discovery of assets, marshalling those assets, providing financial disclosures and the prosecution of claims against brokers. Its cooperation and assistance has aided the Receiver in recovering, preserving, protecting, and distributing Defendants' assets in the most equitable manner.

WHEREFORE, McAfee & Taft, PC, respectfully prays that the Court enter an Order authorizing the Receiver to pay McAfee legal fees in the amount of \$50,221.47 as set forth herein, and for such other and further relief as is just and equitable.
