**FINAL ORDER, JUDGMENT AND PERMANENT INJUNCTION**

This matter came on for hearing this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June, 2017, before the undersigned Judge of the District Court in and for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma, upon motion of Plaintiff, Oklahoma Department of Securities *ex rel.* Irving L. Faught, Administrator (“Plaintiff”), for default judgment against Gary Douglas Warlick (“Defendant”). The Court, finding that it has jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter of this action and the issues having been heard, finds that Plaintiff’s motion for default judgment against Defendant should be, and hereby is, granted.

The Court finds that Defendant was validly served with a summons and the petition in this case and that the date by which Defendants were required to appear and defend this action has passed. No motion or responsive pleading has been filed by or on behalf of Defendant. Defendant has thus admitted the allegations in the petition. The Court, having reviewed the evidence presented, and being fully advised in the premises, and in consideration thereof, finds that the allegations in Plaintiff’s petition are deemed true as set

forth therein, and that the basis for an injunction and other relief has been established by Plaintiff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a permanent injunction be and is hereby entered, forever enjoining and restraining Defendant from transacting business in and/or from the state of Oklahoma as an issuer, issuer agent, broker-dealer, broker-dealer agent, investment adviser, and/or investment adviser representative or otherwise offering and/or selling business opportunities and/or securities in and/or from the state of Oklahoma.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant shall pay restitution to any and all Tilapia Purchasers, Quail Purchasers and Stock Purchasers, as defined in the petition, who purchased business opportunities and/or securities from the Defendants. These purchasers will be identified by this Court and amounts to be paid to such persons will be determined by this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant shall not dispose of, tamper with, alter, or destroy any books, records, documents, files, correspondence, computer disks, tapes or other data recordings of any type, pertaining to or referring to Defendant, his businesses, and/or the offer or sale of business opportunities and/or securities.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Court will retain jurisdiction of this matter for the purpose of enforcement of this Order.


