



undivided interests in oil and gas and interests in limited partnerships ("LP") (collectively, the "Securities").

2. Defendant Johnnie Louis McAlpine ("McAlpine") was in control of SOG and of bank accounts corresponding to SOG and the LPs.

3. SOG employed and associated with unregistered agents who engaged in the offer and sale of the Securities.

4. SOG offering documents contained untrue statements of material fact and omissions of material fact in connection with the offer and sale of the Securities.

5. The untrue statements and omissions of material fact involved misstated oil and gas production numbers, use of investor funds, and McAlpine's prior felony convictions related to misrepresentations made to investors regarding oil and gas production.

Based upon the aforementioned facts to which no substantial controversy exists, the Court finds that Plaintiff is entitled to summary judgment as a matter of law on Plaintiff's claims of violations of §§ 1-301, 1-402(D) and 1-501(2) of the Oklahoma Uniform Securities Act of 2004 ("Act"), Okla. Stat. tit. 71, §§ 1-101 through 1-701 (2011), and, therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That McAlpine, and any entity McAlpine owns and/or controls, is permanently enjoined from transacting business in and/or from the state of Oklahoma as an issuer, agent, broker-dealer, investment adviser and/or investment

adviser representative, as defined in the Act, and from otherwise engaging in the offer and/or sale of securities, directly or indirectly, in and/or from the state of Oklahoma;

2. That McAlpine pay restitution to all investors who purchased the Securities in such amounts and to such persons as determined by this Court and that the Plaintiff is authorized to submit to the Court a claims process to determine restitution amounts;

3. That McAlpine disgorge any and all ill-gotten gains accumulated, directly or indirectly, from the sale of the Securities as determined by this Court; and

4. That an accounting of all of McAlpine's assets be made and filed, no later than 45 days after the date set forth below, with the Plaintiff.

IT IS SO ORDERED.




