
IN THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA

Taylor, Jerry L. Goodman and Tom Colbert. The judges sit in three-judge panels which rotate periodically, but all assigned cases will be decided by three of the above named judges. Any party may seek disqualification of any judge pursuant to Okla.Sup.Ct.R. 1.175, 12 O.S. 2001, Ch. 15, App. 1 and 20 O.S. 2001 §§ 30.3, 1401 and 1402.
