DEFAULT JUDGMENT AGAINST GAIL PLATT AND LONE WOLF, INC.

This matter came on for hearing this 21st day of February, 2006, before the undersigned Judge of the District Court in and for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma, upon the motion of Plaintiff for default judgment against Defendants Gail Platt ("Platt") and Lone Wolf, Inc. ("Lone Wolf") to be heard *instanter*, without notice.

The Court, having reviewed the verified Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief ("Petition"), the Alias Summons, the Proof of Service and the court file, finds: that Defendants Platt and Lone Wolf have been validly served with copies of the Petition and Alias Summons; that the date by which said Defendants were required to appear and defend this action was February 15, 2006; that no appearance was made by said Defendants, nor has any motion or pleading been filed on their behalf; and that a default judgment may be taken against said Defendants without notice, pursuant to Rule 10 of the Rules for District Courts of Oklahoma. The Court further finds that Defendants Platt and Lone Wolf are in default and have

thus admitted the allegations of the Petition; that the allegations of the verified Petition are deemed true as therein set forth; and that Plaintiff is entitled to the relief for which it has prayed against Defendants Platt and Lone Wolf.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendants Platt and Lone Wolf are permanently enjoined from offering or selling securities in or from this state and from directing other natural persons, corporations, or other business entities acting on their behalf to offer or sell securities in or from this state.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant Platt pay restitution to purchasers of stock in Neher Messenger Farms, Inc. ("NMF Investors") in such amounts as should be adjudicated between Defendant Platt and the NMF Investors.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendants Lone Wolf and Platt pay restitution to purchasers of stock or investment contracts of Lone Wolf ("Lone Wolf Investors") in such amounts as should be adjudicated between Defendants Lone Wolf and Platt and the Lone Wolf Investors.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant Platt pay a civil monetary penalty in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) to Plaintiff.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
