**FINAL JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION
AND OTHER EQUITABLE RELIEF**

This matter comes on for hearing on the 23 of Feb, 2004, before the undersigned Judge of the District Court in and for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma, for an order of permanent injunction and restitution. The Oklahoma Department of Securities ("Department") appears through its attorney Gerri Stuckey. Defendant Edward A. Reed ("Defendant") appears pro se.

Defendant, neither admitting nor denying the allegations contained in Plaintiff's Petition filed herein on the 23rd of February, 2004, announces that he agrees to the entry of this order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant shall be enjoined from the date of this order from, directly or indirectly:

1. issuing, offering and/or selling securities in and/or from the state of Oklahoma other than, purchasing or selling securities on his own behalf and for his own account; and

2. transacting business as a broker-dealer or agent as such term is defined in Section 2 of the Act in and/or from the state of Oklahoma.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that Defendant Reed pay a civil monetary penalty pursuant to Section 406.1 of the Act to the Oklahoma Department of Securities in the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) to be paid as follows: Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) within thirty (30) days of the entry of this order and the remaining Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) within one (1) year of the entry of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Court will retain jurisdiction of this matter for the purpose of enforcement of this order.


