**FINAL ORDER, JUDGMENT AND PERMANENT INJUNCTION
FOR EMZIE HULETTY**

This matter came on for hearing this 31 day of March, 2006 before the undersigned Judge of the District Court in and for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma, upon Plaintiff's Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief, pursuant to Section 1-603 of the Oklahoma Uniform Securities Act of 2004 ("Act"), Okla. Stat. tit. 71, §§ 1-101 through 1-701 (Supp. 2003).

After a review of the pleadings and evidence, this Court finds:

1. At all times material hereto, Emzie Huletty ("Defendant Huletty") engaged in the offer and/or sale of securities in the nature of interests in a high-yield investment program ("Investment Program"), in and/or from the state of Oklahoma to investors ("Investors").

2. The Investment Program interests are securities as defined by Section 1-102 of the Act.

3. The securities offered and sold by Defendant Huletty are not, and have not been registered under the Act. The securities have not been offered or sold pursuant to an exemption from registration pursuant to Sections 1-201 or 1-202 of the Act.

4. Defendant Huletty is an agent as defined in Section 1-102 of the Act and transacted business in and/or from the state of Oklahoma as an agent. Defendant Huletty is not registered under the Act in any capacity.

5. Defendant Huletty, in connection with the offer, sale or purchase of securities, directly and indirectly, made untrue statements of material fact and omitted to state material facts necessary in order to make the statements made, in light of the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading, in violation of subsection (2) of Section 1-501 of the Act.

6. Defendant Huletty, in connection with the offer, sale or purchase of securities, and through the use of untrue statements of material facts and omissions of material facts, engaged in an act, practice, or course of business that has operated as a fraud or deceit upon Investors, in violation of subsection (3) of Section 1-501 of the Act.

7. Defendant Huletty distributed sales literature to Investors without filing such sales literature with the Department in violation of Section 1-504 of the Act.

8. Defendant Huletty, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Petition, without making any admissions, and without waiving any privileges available to him, has executed the Stipulation and Consent to Final Order ("Stipulation and Consent") attached hereto

as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof. The Plaintiff has no objection to the terms of the Stipulation and Consent and agrees to the entry of this Final Order, Judgment and Permanent Injunction For Emzie Huletty ("Final Order").

9. There is a likelihood of future violations of the Act by Defendant Huletty if he is not enjoined.

Therefore, based on the pleadings, evidence, and the execution of the Stipulation and Consent, the Court finds that Plaintiff is entitled to the relief prayed for and that this Final Order be issued by agreement of the parties, and, therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a permanent injunction be and is hereby entered, forever enjoining and restraining Defendant Huletty from:

1. offering or selling any security including, but not limited to, an interest in any high-yield investment program, rebate program, coupon program or any other similar program, in and/or from this state; and
2. transacting business in this state as a broker-dealer or agent.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant Huletty be and is forever enjoined and restrained from the use of the internet to promote or market any security including, but not limited to, an interest in any high-yield investment program, rebate program, coupon program or any other similar program in and/or from this state, and from the use of an Oklahoma address or phone number on any website describing or relating to any security including, but not limited to, an interest in any high-yield investment program, rebate program, coupon program or any other similar program.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the allocation of restitution to Investors, if any, shall be determined by this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Court will retain jurisdiction of this matter for the purpose of enforcement of this Final Order and the Stipulation and Consent.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
