ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR RESTITUTION

This matter came on for hearing this 31 day of January, 2002, before the undersigned Judge of the District Court in and for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma upon the motion of Defendant Jerry Thayne Davis ("Davis") for an order extending time to comply with an order of restitution. Plaintiff, the Oklahoma Department of Securities ("Department"), appears through its attorney Patricia A. Labarthe. Defendant Davis appears through his attorney Peter Bradford. The Court, having reviewed all of the evidence offered and the Court file, and being advised that the parties agree to the entry of this order, finds as follows:

On December 30, 1999, the Department filed a Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief pursuant to the Oklahoma Securities Act, Okla. Stat. tit. 71, §§ 1-413, 501, 701-703 (1991 and Supp. 2001).

On July 12, 2001, Davis executed the Stipulation of Jerry Thayne Davis ("Stipulation"), in which Davis agreed to pay restitution on or before December 31, 2001, to Johnnie D. and Peggie Chenault in the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00).

On July 31, 2001, this Court issued an Order of Permanent Injunction against Davis and

ordered Davis to pay restitution on or before December 31, 2001, to Johnnie D. and Peggie Chenault, in the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00).

On January 28, 2002, Davis submitted a cashier's check to the Department in the sum of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00), payable to Johnnie D. and Peggie Chenault. Davis has requested an extension of time to March 31, 2002, to pay the balance due to Johnnie D. and Peggie Chenault of Eighty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$88,000.00), to which the Department has no objection. Johnnie D. and Peggie Chenault also agree to this extension.

Therefore, based on the evidence reviewed and the execution of the Stipulation, the Court finds that the following order should be entered.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Jerry Thayne Davis be granted an extension of time to March 31, 2002, at which time he is ordered to pay restitution to Johnnie D. and Peggie Chenault in the sum of Eighty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$88,000.00).
