ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY INJUNCTION

Plaintiff has moved for a temporary injunction to enjoin defendants from the offer and/or sale of securities, pending final determination of this action on the merits. The Court granted a restraining order on the 29th day of February, 2000, and directed defendants to show cause in a hearing scheduled for March 14, 2000, why such restraining order should not be made a temporary injunction.


Defendants were served with notice of the hearing on the 3rd day of March, 2000, with the service of the restraining order pursuant to 12 O.S. § 1387. Defendants requested, and plaintiff agreed, to four continuances of this hearing. The hearing was subsequently scheduled for the 26th of July, 2000. On the 25th of July, 2000, Defendants contacted this Court and waived their right to a hearing. Defendants represented that they have no objection to the Court entering a temporary injunction.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendants, their subsidiaries, officers, directors, agents, servants, employees, assigns, attorneys and other persons acting on their behalf, under their direction and control, and/or in active concert or participation with them who receive actual notice of this order, by personal service or otherwise, be and hereby are, and until further notice of this Court, enjoined from:

1. offering or selling any security in this state; and
2. transacting business in this state as a broker-dealer, agent, investment adviser and/or investment adviser representative.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that pending determination of the motion for permanent injunction, all conditions of the temporary restraining order remain in effect, the Defendants' assets remain frozen and in the custody, possession and control of the Receiver, Sidney Swinson.
