FINAL JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION
AND OTHER EQUITABLE RELIEF

This matter comes on for hearing on the 23 day of ~~December~~ ^{February}, 2004, before the undersigned Judge of the District Court in and for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma, upon the verified Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief filed by Plaintiff, Oklahoma Department of Securities ("Department"), on April 14, 2003, pursuant to Section 813 of the Oklahoma Business Opportunity Sales Act (the "Act"), Okla. Stat. tit. 71, §§ 801-829 (1991 & Supp. 1999).

Defendants B & B Worm Farm, an unincorporated entity, B & B Worm Farms, Inc., a Nevada corporation, and the Estate of Gregory Miles Bradley (collectively, the "Settling Defendants"), for purposes of this proceeding only, specifically consent to the entry of this Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief, as evidenced by their signatures affixed hereto.

Based upon the foregoing, the Court finds as follows:

1. On April 14, 2003, the Department filed its Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief ("Petition"). Service of Summons and the Petition were properly served on Settling Defendants.

2. This Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this case and the parties hereto.

3. The Petition states claims upon which relief may be granted under the Act against the Settling Defendants.

4. Settling Defendants admit to the allegations in the Petition and based thereon, the Court finds that Settling Defendants violated Sections 806, 808 and 819 of the Act.

5. Settling Defendants waive all rights to seek judicial review or otherwise to challenge the validity of this Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief ("Order").

6. Plaintiff and Settling Defendants agree that this Order shall be construed solely remedial in nature, and shall not be construed as imposing the payment of a fine, penalty, punitive assessment, or forfeiture.

7. Entry of this Order is in the public interest.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Settling Defendants, their agents, servants, employees, assigns, and all persons acting on their behalf, under their direction and control, and/or in active concert or participation with them shall be permanently enjoined from, directly or indirectly, issuing, offering and/or selling any business opportunity in and/or from the state of Oklahoma.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that Defendant, Estate of Gregory Miles Bradley, pay the sum of \$620,000.00 as partial restitution, to purchasers of "Grower Contracts" with Defendants B & B Worm Farm, an unincorporated entity, and/or B & B Worm Farms, Inc.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that claims made by those persons who purchased "Grower Contracts" from Defendants B & B Worm Farm, an unincorporated entity, and/or B & B Worm Farms, Inc., shall be non-dischargeable in the United States Bankruptcy Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that all assets of Defendants B&B Worm Farm, Inc., and the estate of Gregory Miles Bradley, including, but not limited to, those funds located in any bank account of such Defendants, shall be submitted to the custody of Janice D. Loyd, U.S. Trustee for the Bankruptcy of B & B Worm Farm, Inc., Case No. 14379-BH (Chapter 7), *instanter*.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction of this matter for all purposes, including any application or motion by the Department for additional relief within the jurisdiction of this Court.


