FINAL JUDGMENT OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION
AND OTHER EQUITABLE RELIEF

This matter comes on for hearing on the 23 day of ~~December~~ ^{February}, 2004, before the undersigned Judge of the District Court in and for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma, upon the verified Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief filed by Plaintiff, Oklahoma Department of Securities ("Department"), on April 14, 2003, pursuant to Section 813 of the Oklahoma Business Opportunity Sales Act (the "Act"), Okla. Stat. tit. 71, §§ 801-829 (1991 & Supp. 1999).

The Court having examined the pleadings filed herein and having heard statements of counsel for Plaintiff finds that Defendant Lynn Bradley and her counsel consent to the entry of this order as evidenced by their signatures affixed hereto. Lynn Bradley, neither admitting nor denying the allegations contained in Plaintiff's petition filed herein on the 14th day of April, 2003, and for purposes of this proceeding only,

specifically consents to the entry of this Final Judgement of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief.

Based upon the foregoing, the Court finds as follows:

1. On April 14, 2003, the Department filed its Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief (Petition). Service of Summons and the Petition were properly served on Lynn Bradley.

2. This Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this case and the parties hereto.

3. The Petition states claims upon which relief may be granted under the Act against Lynn Bradley.

4. Lynn Bradley violated Sections 806, 808 and 819 of the Act.

5. Lynn Bradley waives all rights to seek judicial review or otherwise to challenge the validity of this Final Judgement of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief ("Order").

6. Entry of this Order is in the public interest.

7. These findings are applicable only to this action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Lynn Bradley her agents, servants, employees, assigns, and all persons acting on her behalf, under her direction and control, and/or in active concert or participation with her shall be permanently enjoined from, directly or indirectly issuing, offering and/or selling any business opportunity in and/or from the state of Oklahoma.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant Lynn Bradley's interest in any and all bank accounts at Arvest Bank shall be submitted to the

custody of Janice D. Loyd, U.S. Trustee for the Bankruptcy of B & B Worm Farm, Inc.,
Case No. 14379-BH (Chapter 7), *instanter*.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction of this matter for all purposes, including any application or motion by the Department for additional relief within the jurisdiction of this Court.


