**JOINT APPLICATION FOR
CONTINUATION OF HEARING**

The Defendant, Renaissance U.S.A., Inc., ("Renaissance") and Plaintiff, Oklahoma Department of Securities ("Department") respectively requests this Court continue the hearing on Plaintiff's Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction for three weeks, or until February 13, 1998.
