TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

This matter came on for hearing this 16<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1998, before the undersigned Judge of the District Court in and for Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma upon the verified Petition for Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief of the Plaintiff and the application therein for a temporary restraining order pursuant to Section 814.A.2. of the Oklahoma Business Opportunity Sales Act ("Act"), Okla. Stat. tit. 71, § 801-827, (1991 & Supp. 1997).

It appears to this Court from the facts alleged in Plaintiff's verified Petition that Plaintiff is entitled to the relief prayed for; it further appears that the public will suffer irreparable damage and injury unless the Defendants, their officers, directors, employees, agents, and other individuals acting on their behalf and under their direction and control are restrained forthwith and without notice.

It further appears to the Court that if the issuance of this temporary restraining order is delayed until notice is given to the opposing party there is a strong likelihood violations of the Act may occur. The irreparable injury to be suffered by Plaintiff is the continued violations of the Act by Defendants if not temporarily restrained.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Renaissance U.S.A., Inc. and Randall D. Jeffers, their officers, directors, employees, agents, and other individuals in active concert or participation with them who receive actual notice of this order, by personal service or otherwise, and each of them, be, and hereby are, instanter and until further notice of this Court, enjoined and restrained from:


1. the offer and sale of business opportunities from or in this state unless and until such business opportunities are registered by the Defendants and revoke any exemption claim made by Defendants pursuant to the Act;
2. the offer and sale of business opportunities from or in this state unless and until a written disclosure document prepared pursuant to Section 808 of the Act is delivered to each purchaser as required by the Act; and
3. directly or indirectly omitting to state material facts necessary to make statements made, in light of the circumstances under which they were made, not misleading in connection with the offer and sale of business opportunities from or in this state.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a hearing is hereby set at 9:00 o'clock A.M. on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of January, 1998, before the Honorable Judge Blevins of the Oklahoma County District Court, Oklahoma County Courthouse, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, at which time the Defendants may seek the dissolution of this Temporary Restraining Order.


