ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST

On July 31, 2002, the Administrator of the Oklahoma Department of Securities (Administrator) was served with a Recommendation to Issue an Order to Cease and Desist and Imposing Civil Penalty (Recommendation) against Rubaroc International, Inc. (Rubaroc, Inc.), Rubaroc International, Ltd. (Rubaroc, Ltd.) and Barry E. Meakings (Meakings) (collectively referred to as "Respondents"), pursuant to the Oklahoma Business Opportunity Sales Act (Act), Okla. Stat. tit. 71, §§ 801-829 (2001).

On July 31, 2002, the Administrator issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing with the Recommendation attached (Notice). The Notice advised the Respondents of their right to request a hearing to show why an order based on the Recommendation should not be issued pursuant to Section 818.F of the Act. The Notice was mailed to Rubaroc, Inc., Rubaroc, Ltd. and Meakings at 10902 Spicewood Parkway, Austin, Texas 78750, which was returned marked "Returned To Sender, Not Deliverable As Addressed." The Notice was also mailed to Rubaroc, Inc., Rubaroc, Ltd. and Meakings at 238 Starlane Drive, La Canada, CA 91011, which was returned marked "Returned To Sender, Attempted Not Known, No Such Number." The Notice was also mailed to Rubaroc, Inc. and Meakings at 2306 Lakeshore Road West, Oakville, Ontario L6L 1H3, which was returned marked "Return To Sender, Moved, Address Unknown, Closed." The Notice was also mailed to Rubaroc, Ltd. and Meakings, at 53 Chantry Road, Marden, Tonbridge, Kent TN12 9HU. No return on this address has been received to date.

On July 31, 2002, service of the Notice was made on the Administrator pursuant to Section 818.F of the Act. Such notice constitutes valid personal service as to Respondents.

The Notice specified that failure to request a hearing within fifteen (15) days of service will result in the issuance of an order to cease and desist and imposing civil

penalty. The Administrator received no request for hearing within the time limits specified in the Notice.

The Administrator, being fully advised in the premises, hereby finds that this action is necessary and appropriate in the public interest and sets forth the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

Findings of Fact

1. At all times material hereto, Rubaroc, Inc. was a corporation located at 2306 Lakeshore Road West, Oakville, ON L6L 1H3.

2. At all times material hereto, Rubaroc, Ltd. was an entity located at 53 Chantry Road, Marden, Tonbridge, Kent TN12 9HU.

3. At all times material hereto, Meakings was the president of Rubaroc, Inc. and Rubaroc, Ltd.

4. In June, 2001, Respondents offered and sold to an Oklahoma resident an exclusive distributor agreement ("Distributor Agreement") to market, sell and install synthetic safety surfacing.

5. Under the terms of the Distributor Agreement, Rubaroc, Inc. agreed to provide training for selling and installing the product, all marketing literature, sales leads, technical and sales assistance, and a co-op advertising program.

6. The Distributor Agreement was not registered under the Act.

To the extent any of these Findings of Fact are more properly characterized as Conclusions of Law, they should be so considered.

Conclusions of Law

1. The Distributor Agreement is a business opportunity.

2. Rubaroc, Inc., Rubaroc, Ltd. and Meakings offered and/or sold a business opportunity in the state of Oklahoma.

3. The offer and sale of the Distributor Agreement by Rubaroc, Inc., Rubaroc, Ltd. and Meakings without registration under the Act is a violation of Section 806 of the Act.

4. It is in the public interest to order Rubaroc, Inc., Rubaroc, Ltd. and Meakings to cease and desist from engaging in violations of the Act.

To the extent any of these Conclusions of Law are more properly characterized as Findings of Fact, they should be so considered.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondents cease and desist from engaging in violations of Section 806 of the Act.
