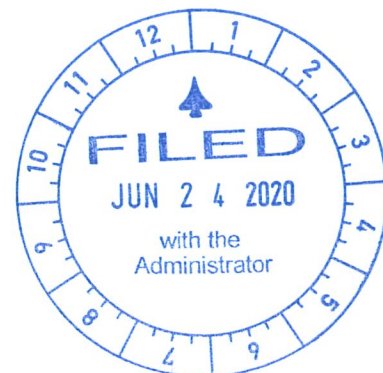

These are my answers to the questions sent to me, for the Order to File Statements and Admissions, Filed on April 10, 2020.

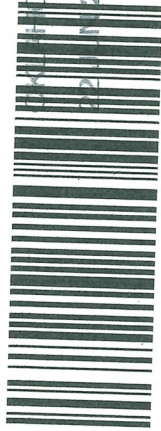
