120143 Derek Tyner et al. v. Vic Regalado



Appellant's motion for an extension of time to file the brief in chief is granted. The brief in chief shall be filed not later than **October 26, 2022**. Rule 1.6(b) Okla.S.Ct. Rules. No further extensions of time are contemplated.

Appellee is directed to file, no later than **October 21, 2022**, an original and fourteen copies of a bound Answer Brief in compliance with Rules 1.10 and 1.11 of the Oklahoma Supreme Court Rules. The brief shall be securely bound and fastened along the left side with spiral or plastic finger-spine binding and shall be bound so as to be flat upon opening. The unbound appellee's Response Brief filed on October 3, 2022 is stricken from the record.
